### Message: Fault Lines by Bobby Osborn

January 3, 2021

We know, Lord. There is a move. We want to be right there in the center of that move." (our prayer today). Start the year with a shout of triumph. A shout of victory. This is our year.

**Challenge to us:** "Leave 2020 behind." Whatever you went through last year, leave it behind. It has to be a different year. If you feel like you can't make it. God is reaching out saying 2021 can have a brand new look, a brand new feel and new confidence - only through Him (Jesus)

**Read Psalms 133:1** A reminder to dwell together in unity

Behold, how good and how pleasant it is  
For brothers to dwell together in unity!

It is like the precious oil upon the head,  
Coming down upon the beard,  
Even Aaron's beard,

Coming down upon the edge of his robes.  
It is like the dew of Hermon

Coming down upon the mountains of Zion;  
For there the Lord commanded the blessing—life forever.

**Read I Corinthians 12:12-24**

For even as the body is one and *yet* has many members, and all the members of the body, though they are many, are one body, so also is Christ. <sup>13</sup> For <sup>[a]</sup>by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.

<sup>14</sup> For the body is not one member, but many. <sup>15</sup> If the foot says, "Because I am not a hand, I am not *a part* of the body," it is not for this reason <sup>[b]</sup>any the less *a part* of the body. <sup>16</sup> And if the ear says, "Because I am not an eye, I am not *a part* of the body," it is not for this reason <sup>[c]</sup>any the less *a part* of the body.

<sup>17</sup> If the whole body were an eye, where would the hearing be? If the whole were hearing, where would the sense of smell be? <sup>18</sup> But now God has placed the members, each one of them, in the body, just as He desired. <sup>19</sup> If they were all one member, where would the body be?

<sup>20</sup> But now there are many members, but one body. <sup>21</sup> And the eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you"; or again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you." <sup>22</sup> On the contrary, <sup>[d]</sup>it is much truer that the members of the body which seem to be weaker are necessary;

<sup>23</sup> and those *members* of the body which we <sup>[e]</sup>deem less honorable, <sup>[f]</sup>on these we bestow more abundant honor, and our less presentable members become much more presentable, <sup>24</sup> whereas our more presentable members have no need *of it*. But God has *so* composed the body, giving more abundant honor to that *member* which lacked.
